To our distinguished partners gathered here today, I extend my deepest gratitude for your tireless efforts and commitment in supporting the full achievement of this agreement, which also showcases our shared resolve to contribute proactively to regional peace, security, and stability.

As we look ahead, next year marks the 70th Anniversary of the Normalization of Diplomatic Relations between Japan and the Philippines. Let us build on this momentum and continue working hand -in-hand. Ensuring that the RAA and our broader cooperation leave a lasting legacy where our nations stand stronger together, and our region thrives in peace, prosperity and unity.
